

Become a Master Gardener!

Master Gardeners are trained volunteers who aid the University of Wisconsin Extension staff by helping people in their community better understand horticulture and their environment.

To become a certified Master Gardener:

- Complete the 36 hours of general training
- Achieve a 70% or better on the final exam
- Complete 24 hours of volunteer service within one year of training
- Cost is \$125 for training and manual
