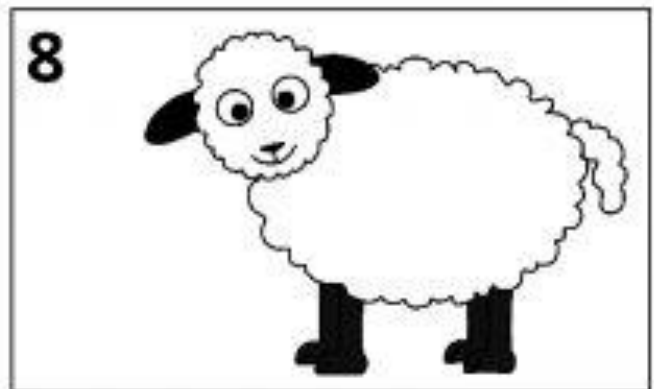
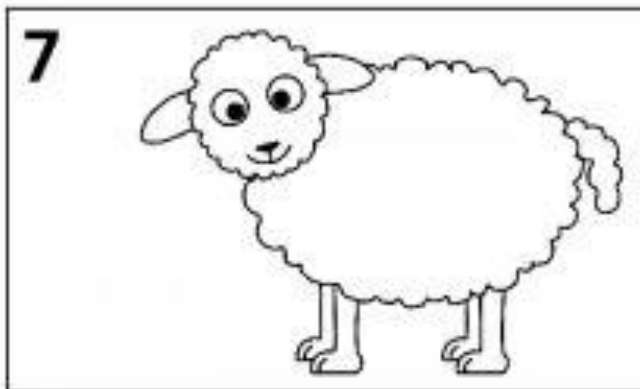
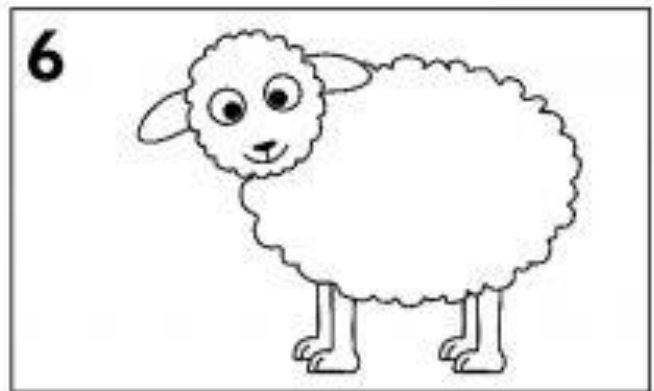
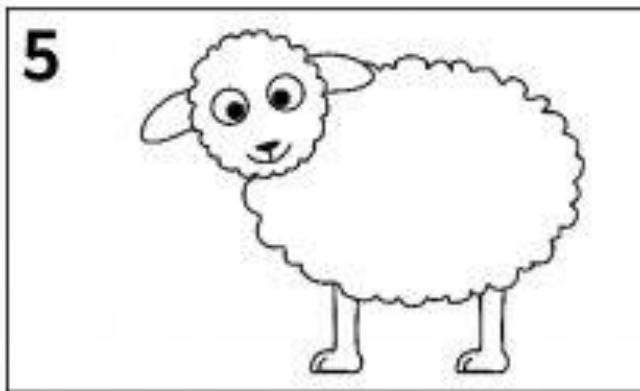
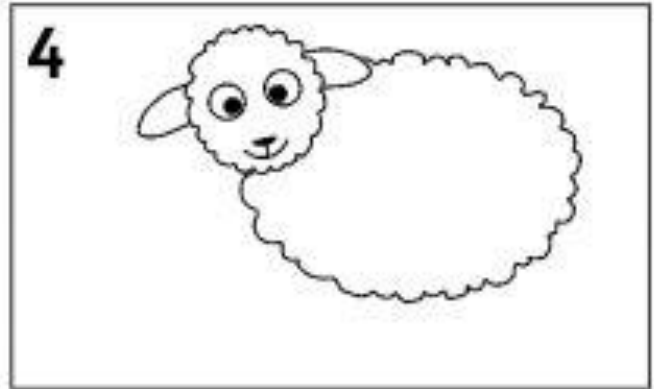
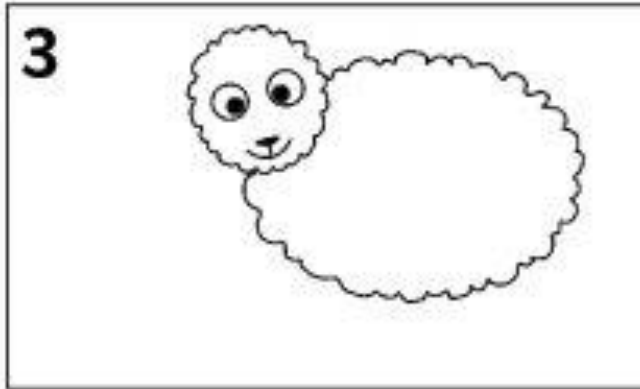
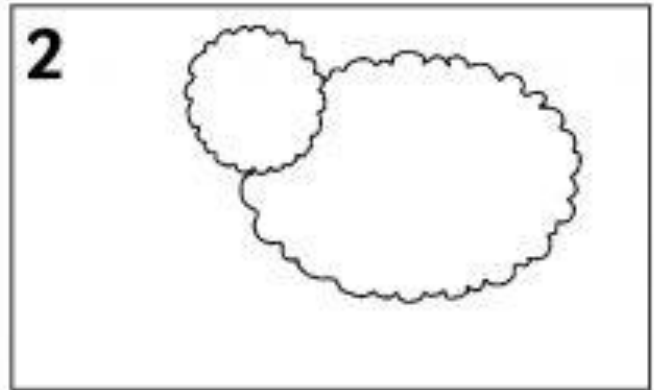
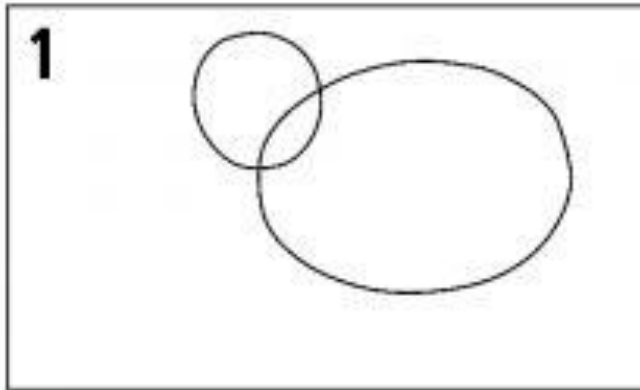
Sea Search

















To learn about animals, it is important to study them. One way to do that is by drawing your animals - it is a good exercise for your brain to pay attention to features and details about your animal. But drawing animals can be really hard. So grab a blank piece of paper and follow the steps below to draw a sheep! Remember, all animals are different just like you, so don't worry about being perfect.



Cover Your Tracks

Carefully cut out the square tiles below or ask for help. Then, turn them all face down and mix them up. With a partner, take turns flipping over 2 cards at a time to find a match. If they are not a match, flip them back over. If they are a match, you keep them. The player who matched the most animals to their tracks wins!

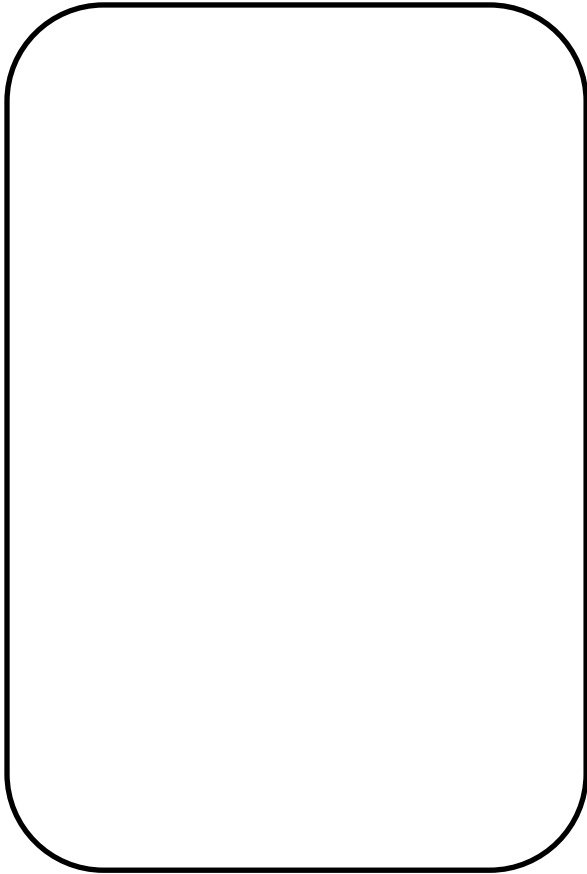

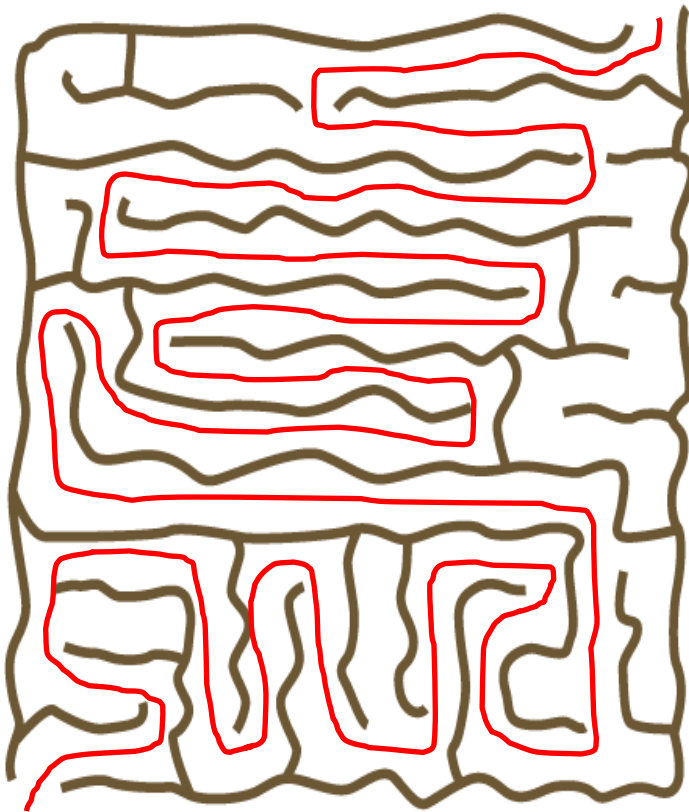
