

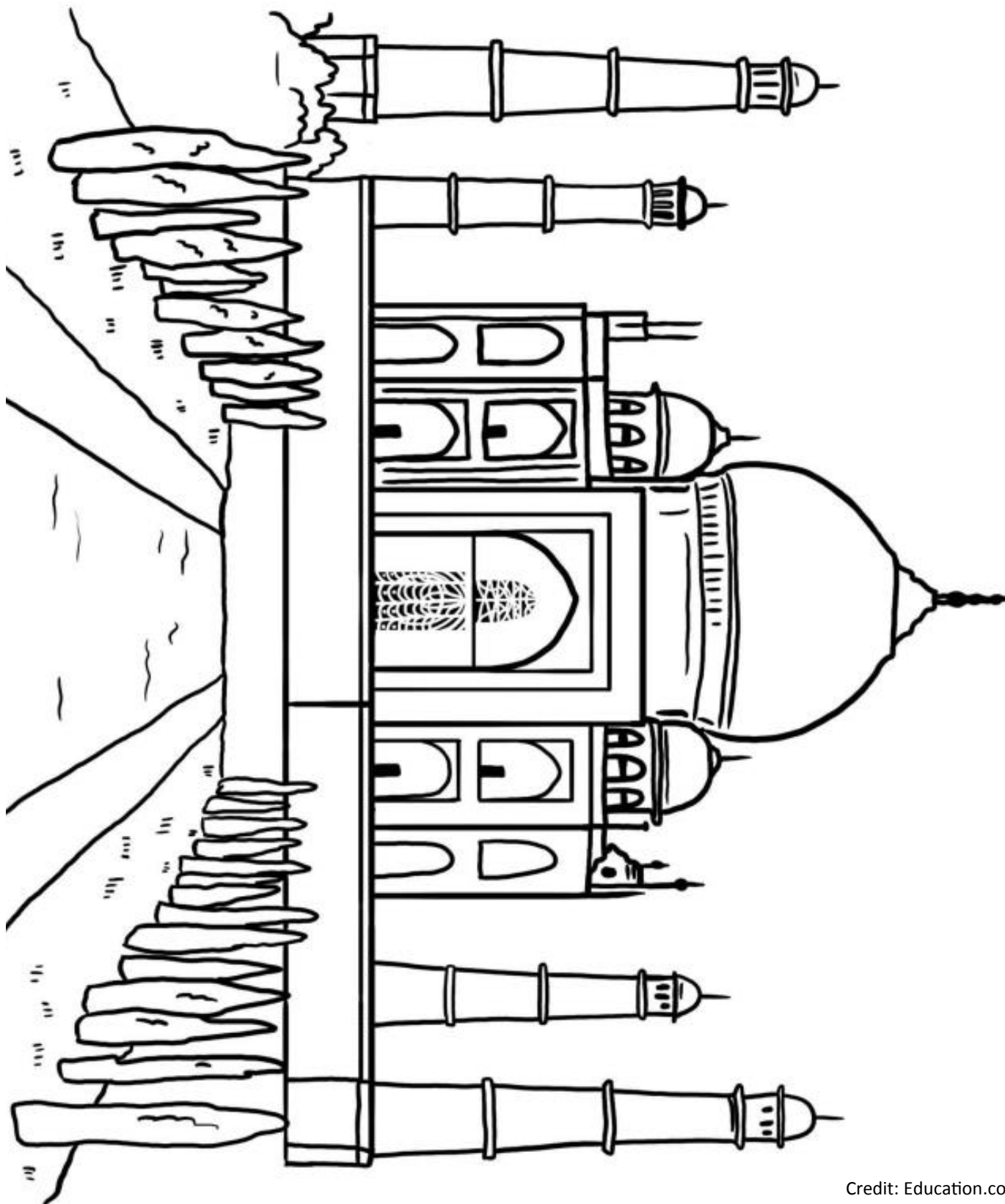

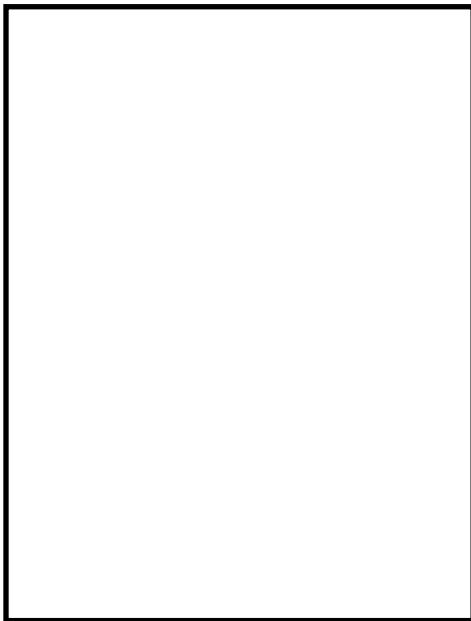
Passport to Peru

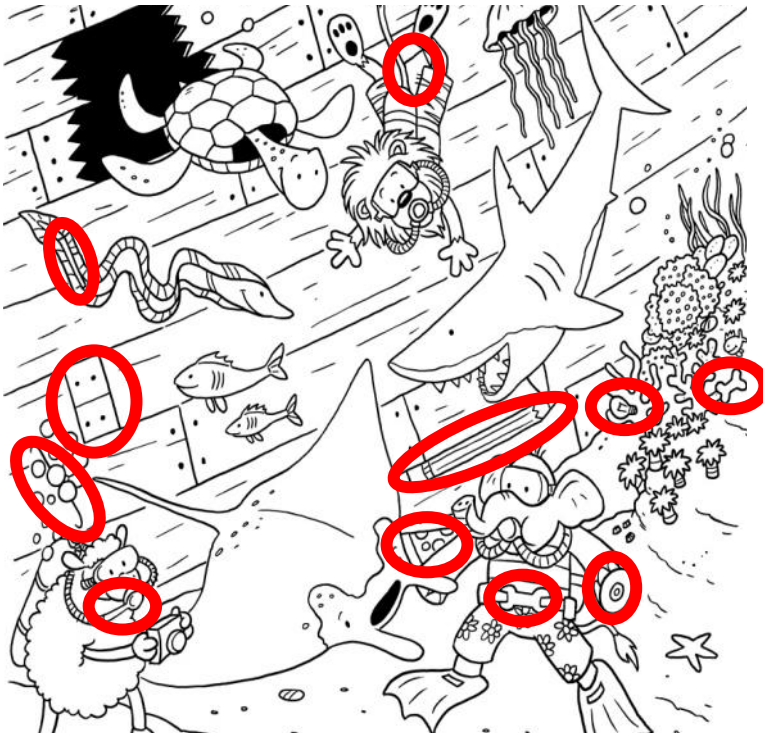
