aims to create a visible network of support for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, questioning, asexual, and queer individuals and their allies by providing an avenue through which any member of our community can show their support. The program also extends a physical sense of space for LGBTQ+ individuals and their allies.

**There is a pressure to already know how to be LGBTQ+ inclusive. And while many of us want to be, we don't necessarily feel comfortable with the language, with our own level of understanding, and don't know where to go to learn more. Safe Zone trainings are safe places for people to go to learn more, about their own gender/sexuality and deepen their understanding of the LGBTQ+ identity and issues.**
