- 1. Applications must be submitted using the form below. Use only the space provided. Do not attach separate sheets, clippings, etc., except for specific items listed below.
- 2. Applicants must have been an active 4-H member for no less than 5 years. The application is limited to graduating high school seniors who have been an active 4-H member for no less than 5 years and are currently enrolled as a La Crosse County 4-H member.
- 3. Applicant must be enrolling in a university, college, or technical school by the fall term immediately following their senior year of high school.
- 4. Attach a copy of your most recent high school transcript. This must come in <u>with</u> your application.
- 5. Applications must be typed or word processed and complete or they will not be considered.
- 6. Completed applications are due in the Extension La Crosse County Office by **Midnight March 1st**. No late forms will be accepted; no exceptions.
- 7. Up to 5 scholarships may be given each year and not all scholarships may be given out each year. All scholarships will be evaluated, so be sure to use details when telling "Your 4-H Story." A minimum level of quality work must be attained to receive a scholarship.
- 8. The scholarship amount varies according to the evaluation of the application. High quality writing, many years of involvement, growing as a leader, and being involved in more than just the 4-H club are some of the key factors that play a role in determining scholarships. The scholarship will be made payable to the recipient.
