- What: Waterhemp is the most troublesome weed in Wisconsin field crops, and there are populations of waterhemp in the area that are resistant to several herbicide modes of action. It is critical for farmers to implement solid plans to manage this weed.

- 2. Systems approach to weed management on a field by field basis,
