#### State Fair Art Submission Instructions:

WI State Fair is again sponsoring rosette ribbons for a judges favorite, one per judge for various departments.

Each judge will receive one Judge's Favorite Award ribbon, per day judged, to award. There are letters for the judges and exhibitor paperwork that needs to be completed and turned in by Monday, July 24, 2023. With items that are selected needing to be AT the state fair grounds no later than Tuesday, July 25th at 3pm. Projects are released from the state fair Wednesday, August 16 from 10 am to 2 pm.

If your exhibit receives a Judges Choice rosette ribbon – you will need to complete a fair amount of paperwork on Sunday July 23 at the fairgrounds. Prepare to fill out a W-9 form for potential premiums, this may mean numbers you won't know off the top of your head.

Local drop off for state fair items is ONLY Sunday, July 23 6-7 pm at the New Youth Building on the fair grounds. Drop off your item at your own risk, and it will be eligible for pick up Sept 1, 2023 from our office. You are welcome to mail or drop off/pick up your exhibit yourself as well.

Food Stand Update: It's time to grab any open shift in the food stand! If you are unable to work during your club shift, then sign up for any other openings available. Reminder that working at the food stand will help any future scholarship applications for 4-H trips, etc. The food stand is our primary fundraiser that keeps our program running smoothly. #### record books deadline

A 4-H Record Book is all about reflecting on your projects ... bringing more meaning to what you learned, how you learned it, and how you can grow from it! Record books are the final step of your 4-H year; your record book tells your story of your project(s) from beginning to end. It tells what you had hoped to accomplish when you signed up to take the project, as well as the journey of learning along the way. In the end, it gives a recap of what happened – did it go well, did it not go so well, what would you do differently, etc. It is your chance to make sure you have reached the goals you set for yourself when you began your project(s), as well as an opportunity for reflection. 4-H Record Books are a big part of achieving in 4-H!

Why complete a record book?

In La Crosse County 4-H, completing a Record Book allows you to compete for multiple county project awards. These awards are given at the annual Achievement Celebration. Record Book awards are given based on what you have learned in your project, not how you did in any competition (fair, foods revue, etc).
