No one is immune to it, myself included. Understanding the marketing and nuances of algorithms also does little to deter most to the charm of blue light. In fact, I found myself missing my algorithm, like an old friend. Something that took time and effort to build.

Seeking out another method felt foreign because it was like starting over. Sounds a little ridiculous, doesn't it? However, if you have a kid who loves youtube or Tik Tok or whatever it is these days they are drawn to, try your best to not dismiss their interest as something trivial or trashy. Because like an old Netflix show in the background, these have grown to be a source of comfort for youth.

With any addiction, simply removing the source cold-turkey can work, however, if you don't take care of the specific need, then you won't have a high chance of succeeding. Is your youth needing connection, inspiration, or stimulation? What other ways can they fill those needs without the other source? Take care of the need or root of the issue and that will help you restore balance.

And with everything we consume or do, finding a healthy balance is key. Maybe you don't have to remove the source if it isn't detrimental to their ability to enjoy life away from screens, or if it doesn't affect schoolwork or behavior. Regardless, I hope you and your family find some time to breathe, sit in some sun, and close your eyes.

Put away the blue screen, and see the blue skies – take in some Spring!
