Food Stand Day Chair Duties



An Overview of Responsibilities and Best Practices

Being a day chair is a role that comes with a myriad of responsibilities and requires a diverse skill set. The day chair acts as a pivotal point of coordination and leadership, ensuring that daily operations run smoothly and efficiently. This document outlines the key duties associated with this role, providing a comprehensive guide for those who are new to the position or seeking to enhance their understanding and performance.

Responsibilities

One of the primary duties of a day chair is to get things ready, help keep things moving smoothly and coordinate. This can vary by shift but ultimately involves:

- Stand and Food Preparation: Ensure that food and appliances are warmed, prepared, and ready to be served depending on your shift. (See chart for details)
- Efficiency: Check with cashier periodically to see if more change is needed, more menus for servers, etc. If more cash/menus are needed in your stand, visit the trailer behind the stand. Notify a food stand manager if more food needs to be ordered.
- Food Safety: Make sure kitchen workers are wearing white aprons, Hair net or hats
- Liaison: Acting as a liaison between club coordinator and manager for needs. The club coordinator needs to stay in the stand, you have the ability to move around as necessary.
- Communication: Ensure the club coordinator understands their role and process at the
 beginning of their shift (give them the free drink coupons to hand out to their clubs at the
 end of their shift). Help the cashier understand the charge slip process. Help the food
 stocker know where to go for more as necessary.
- Conflict Resolution: Addressing any conflicts or issues that arise within the team, working towards effective and amicable solutions, notifying managers of any issues.
- Adjustments and Flexibility: Be prepared to adjust the food stand as needed, accommodating any unforeseen changes or urgent tasks that may arise, such as inclement weather, conflict, or emergency situations.
- Motivation and Morale: Keeping the team motivated and maintaining high morale, fostering a positive and productive work environment. You also agree to abide by <u>WI 4-H Volunteer</u> Behavior Expectations.
