The primary responsibility of the Cloverbud Helper is to help keep the area clean and stocked as they are able. Here is more information to help you do just that!

• At the start of your shift, check in with the day chair on the west side of the food stand. Put on a nametag, and a green apron, and wash your hands!

Cloverbud helpers hang around the order taking area and help as needed.

- PARENT OR GUARDIAN MUST WORK ON THE SAME SHIFT
- Will wipe the counter as necessary to keep it clean.
- Help clean any tables outside, push in chairs, etc.
- Pick up and throw away any trash on the floor or counter or tables outside.
- Help the stocker refill pop, shelves and napkins as necessary.
- Older Cloverbuds may need to fold pizza boxes in Stand 2.
- There may be other odd jobs for them as well, the club coordinator or day chair may need assistance!
- When your shift is done, you get a coupon for a free beverage from the Food Stand. Put your apron back on the hook outside, hand it to the next Cloverbud, or put it in the laundry basket if it's really dirty. Grab your personal items from the cupboard and thank you for donating your time and talents to help us have a successful Fair!
