Food Wrapper Duties



The primary responsibility of anyone assigned to Food Wrapper is to assemble burgers/cheeseburgers and wrap the food from the kitchen. Here is more information to help you do just that!

- At the start of your shift, check in with the day chair on the west side of the food stand. Put on a nametag, a white apron, and hair net (if needed – otherwise wear a hat).
- Wash your hands and put on gloves.
- If you use your gloved hands to touch something dirty, replace your gloves.

The Food Wrapper stands at the end of the counter behind the griller in Stand 2.

- There are cooked burgers in crocks.
- Put the meat and/or cheese on the bun and wrap in deli paper.
- You may need to wrap hot dogs as well from the Pizza/Hot Dog handler.
- Keep up on supplies of buns, deli wraps, boats for the fries/cheese curds and cheese squares.
- Assist Order Dispatcher with any condiments, food from the warmer, or utensil needs.
- When your shift is done, you get a coupon for a free beverage from the Food Stand. Throw away your gloves, apron and hair net, grab your personal items from the cupboard, and thank you for donating your time and talents to help us have a successful Fair!
