La Crosse County 4-H Slushy Maker Duties



The primary responsibility of the Slushy Maker is to make delicious slushies and maintain the machine. Here is more information to help you do just that!

- At the start of your shift, check in with the day chair on the west side of the food stand. Put on a nametag, a green apron.
- Wash your hands.
- The slushy machine sits in the aisle between each food stand, along with the nacho maker. You will get orders from both sides.

Making the slushies:

- You MUST follow the instructions correctly by the machine or it will break.
- Pay attention to orders and the levels of mix and water in the machine.
- Refill the Premix when it drops below the top plate (mix is in the silver fridge in stand 2).
- Notify a day chair **Immediately** if there is no mix in the fridge.
- Previous makers suggest 2 pumps of flavor at the bottom of the cup for a straight flavor. If someone request a combo, one pump each, then add the ice mix.
- Use designated cleaning bucket, located by the machine, to clean the flavoring is sticky and will stain!
- When your shift is done, you get a coupon for a free beverage from the Food Stand. Put your apron back on the hook outside, hand it to the next operator, or put it in the laundry hamper if it's dirty. Grab your personal items from the cupboard and thank you for donating your time and talents to help us have a successful Fair!
