



HELP FROM OTHERS


Teens and adults teach youth in the 4-H program. They will share what they know in a fun way. You can learn so much in 4-H!

The four H's stand for:


Head, Heart, Hands, and Health.

The colors of 4-H are green and white. Green stands for youth and springtime. White stands for purity.



- Have an adult help you print and cut out pictures about the 4-H Camp or Activity you want to talk about!


